

Organization of the Exhibition Addressing the Novel Coronavirus

(2019-nCoV)

The exhibition, **TECHNO-FRONTIER 2020 / INDUSTRY-FRONTIER 2020 / Transport Infrastructure WEEK 2020**, will take place as scheduled.

In January 2020, the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare announced that it had detected Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) in a pneumonia patient in Japan who had previously visited Wuhan, China.

In line with government guidelines, the Exhibition Secretariat has instituted the following measures today (February 4th), in close liaison and collaboration with the venue (**Makuhari Messe**).

■ Venue (**Makuhari Messe**)

Installation of alcohol disinfectant dispensers and warnings placed on the website

Installation location: Public space of each venue entrance

■ Secretariat

- Installation of alcohol disinfectant dispensers

Installation location: Entrances of all exhibition halls

- First-aid rooms have been established, with full-time nursing staff

* Exhibitors from Hubei Province, China have been prohibited to exhibit in line with government guidelines.

To prevent infection of the Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) as well as colds and flus which are also common at this time of year, exhibitors and visitors are asked to practice normal countermeasures against infection, such as observing coughing etiquette and washing their hands.
